In a BHCA sanctioned test, a Hunting Hound (HH), Senior Hunting Hound (SHH), Master Hunting Hound (MHH), or Master Hunting Hound Excellent (MHE) may be earned. Each entry must specify "Q" or "NQ" indicating whether or not that hound is intending to qualify for a title. Only one "Q" entry may be submitted for each hound at a test. A hound must earn 3 qualifying scores in solo, brace, or 2-coupled pack to earn an HH. Once having the HH, the hound must compete in one of the other remaining stakes for it's SHH, and then in the remaining stake to earn an MHH and MHE.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying hounds. For hounds completing 3 qualifying scores at each level a Rosette will be given and a title certificate with hound's name, owner's name, date will be mailed to all qualifying hounds.

Hounds will be judged using the following categories of hunting ability: (1) ability to find game, (2) use of voice, (3) line ability, (4) adaptability, (5) determination each on a scale of 1 to 10; (6) gun shyness is judged on a pass/fail basis. In order to pass this test a hound must score at least 5 on each of the 5 categories and an average of 6 for all categories when all judge's scores are tallied. Handlers shall be exhibit control of their hounds during testing.

Exhibitor Information: This test is open to hounds of the breeds specified that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained ILP or PAL numbers, except for aggressive hounds or hounds suffering from any deformity, injury or illness, which may affect the hound's physical or mental performance.

Safety of the hounds is a primary concern. The test running grounds are open meadows and olive groves. No releasing dogs on rabbits except as instructed by the judges during the trial. All hounds must be on leash at all times except when being tested. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their hounds, guests and children. Anyone engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the test committee, be asked to leave the trial site.

Bitches in season are not permitted at this test and entry fee will be refunded if a bitch entered in solo stake is in season at time of test. If a bitch in season has been entered in brace or pack another hound may be substituted. Refunds will be given if the secretary is notified by Wednesday, February 17, 2021.

Judges are not required to wait for hounds. Owners or handlers of each hound are solely responsible for the dog being ready to perform.

DIRECTIONS TO HUNT TEST GROUNDS –

PLEASE Check for current road closures, some roads maybe closed due to flooding

FROM Interstate 15 Freeway: Take Limonite Ave (exit 103) West until it dead ends at Archibald Ave. and turn left (South). Go 1 mile to Schleisman Rd and turn right (West). Schleisman Rd becomes Pine Ave. west of Hellman Ave. Continue West on Pine Avenue to Chino Corona Road and turn left (South). Drive past California Institute for Women (on your right side) to the Stop sign at the intersection of Chino Corona Road and Cucamonga Ave. Go straight on Cucamonga Ave.

FROM 91 Freeway: Take SR 71 Corona Expressway North. Take the Euclid Ave./Butterfield Ranch Rd. exit. Go NORTH 2 miles on Euclid Ave. (past the main entrance to Prado Regional Park) to Pine Avenue; turn right (EAST). Go 1.2 miles to Chino Corona Road and turn right (SOUTH). Drive past California Institute for Women (on your right side) to the Stop sign at the intersection of Chino Corona Road and Cucamonga Ave. Go straight on Cucamonga Ave.

General Guidelines and Best Practices for this Event:

1. Parking area - all cars and RVs must be parked a minimum distance of 12 feet apart. Including OVERNIGHT RV CAMPING.
2. We must park away from the PVMAC snack bar and we also cannot use the picnic tables, so participants will have to plan accordingly.
3. Bring your own food and drinks—the clubs will not be providing any food or snacks. Make sure you have enough water for you and your dogs.
4. Practice social distancing by maintaining a 6- 12 feet distance between you and others who are not from your own household. Avoid congregating when ever possible.
5. Everyone must wear masks and social distance, including when in the Grove. The Gallery shall maintain social distancing while out in the field.
6. Consider wearing disposable or washable gloves.
7. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
9. All participants also must provide their own personal protective equipment including face coverings and gloves, as necessary and required. We will ask that you bring your own hand sanitizer.
10. Please wash hands as frequently as possible
11. **Pre-entries are encouraged. No one will be permitted to fill out entry forms at the secretary table. The secretary will not make change for entry fees so participants will need to come prepared with the exact cash or pay with a check.**
12. Everyone must bring his or her own pens and pencils.

In a nutshell, it's a “bring your own everything...”

I know this is a long list of rules but these are the conditions for us to be able to hold our events. PVMAC was instrumental in helping us get approval so all of the above will be strictly enforced to insure that we do not jeopardize PVMAC or our future events. I would be remiss by not mentioning that all of the above conditions are subject to change, including cancellation of our events.

Note: The PVMAC Port-A-Potties and hand washing station are available to us (thank goodness).
